## SB-2 (Atkins) - Building Homes and Jobs Act.

Establishes the Building Homes and Jobs Act and imposes a \$75 fee on real estate transaction documents, excluding commercial and residential real estate sales, to provide a permanent source of funding for affordable housing.

## SB-3 (Beall) - Veterans and Affordable Housing Bond Act of 2018.

This urgency bill enacts the Veterans and Affordable Housing Bond Act of 2018 and authorizes the issuance of \$4 billion in general obligation (GO) bonds for affordable housing programs and a veteran's home ownership program, subject to approval by the voters in the November 6, 2018 election.

While I understand the author's intent of needing to address factors that contribute to the unnecessary collisions and deaths of young Californians on our highways, the provisions of this bill create a burden on a segment of adult Californians that are no longer seen as a minor in the eyes of the law. Eighteen year olds are eligible to enlist in the military, vote in national, state, and local elections, enter into contracts, and buy their own car. I believe adults should not be subject to the same driving restrictions presently applied to minors.

When I vetoed a similar bill in 2013, I believed that efforts would be better focused on teen driver training and education programs that improve transportation safety for provisional drivers. That is still my view today.

I am returning Assembly Bill 45 without my signature.

This bill establishes a new program under the Department of Housing and Community Development for the purpose of providing predevelopment grants and loans to developers for the creation of affordable rental housing for school district employees.

I recently signed Senate Bill 2 into law which provides an ongoing funding source for housing. In the first year, SB 2 directs fifty percent of the funding to be made available to local governments for planning purposes. In subsequent years, seventy percent of the funding is directly allocated to local governments so they can address their own unique housing needs and fifteen percent of the funding will be targeted towards workforce housing through the California Housing Financing Authority.

Rather than creating a new program at this time, I encourage the author to work with the local governments in his district and collaborate with the California Housing Financing Authority to maximize the funding in SB 2.

# AB-458 (Frazier) - Vehicle registration.

Reduces the minimum fleet size eligibility requirement for the Permanent Fleet Registration (PFR) program under DMV and requires DMV to charge a \$3 fee to cover vehicle registration processing and payment and titling transactions, as well as services related to reporting vehicle sales and producing temporary license plates, under the Business Partner Automation (BPA) program. Under the PFR program, DMV issues a PFR fleet sticker for all the veihcles in a fleet and sends monthly notifications to the fleet owner of which registrations are expiring. Under the BPA program, DMV contracts with qualified private industry business partners – including car dealers, vehicle dismantlers, smog test centers, auto insurers, and rental car companies – to provide services including processing of transactions such as vehicle registrations, titling transactions, and issuance of license plates.

# AB-544 (Bloom) - Vehicles: high-occupancy vehicle lanes.

Modifies the Clean Air Vehicle (CAV) Program, which enables certain low-emission vehicles to access carpool lanes with a single occupant, and creates a new program to take effect when the CAV program sunsets in 2019. Allows CAV (green and white) stickers issued prior to January 1, 2017, to expire on January 1, 2019. Allows owners or lessees of vehicles with CAV stickers issued between January 1, 2017, and January 1, 2019, to apply to DMV for a new sticker that shall be valid until January 1, 2022. Provides that stickers issued on or after January 1, 2019, will be valid until January 1 of the fourth year after the year of issuance. Prohibits DMV from issuing a CAV sticker to an applicant who has received a Clean Vehicle Rebate Project rebate, unless the applicant's income falls below specified income limits.
