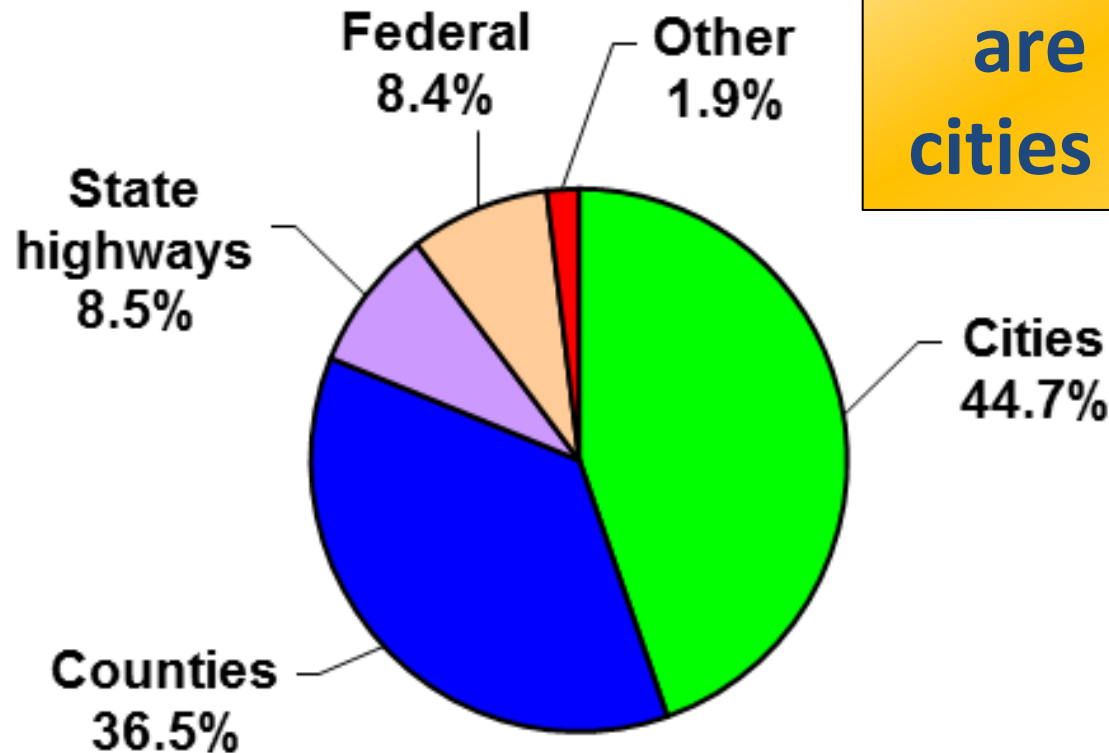

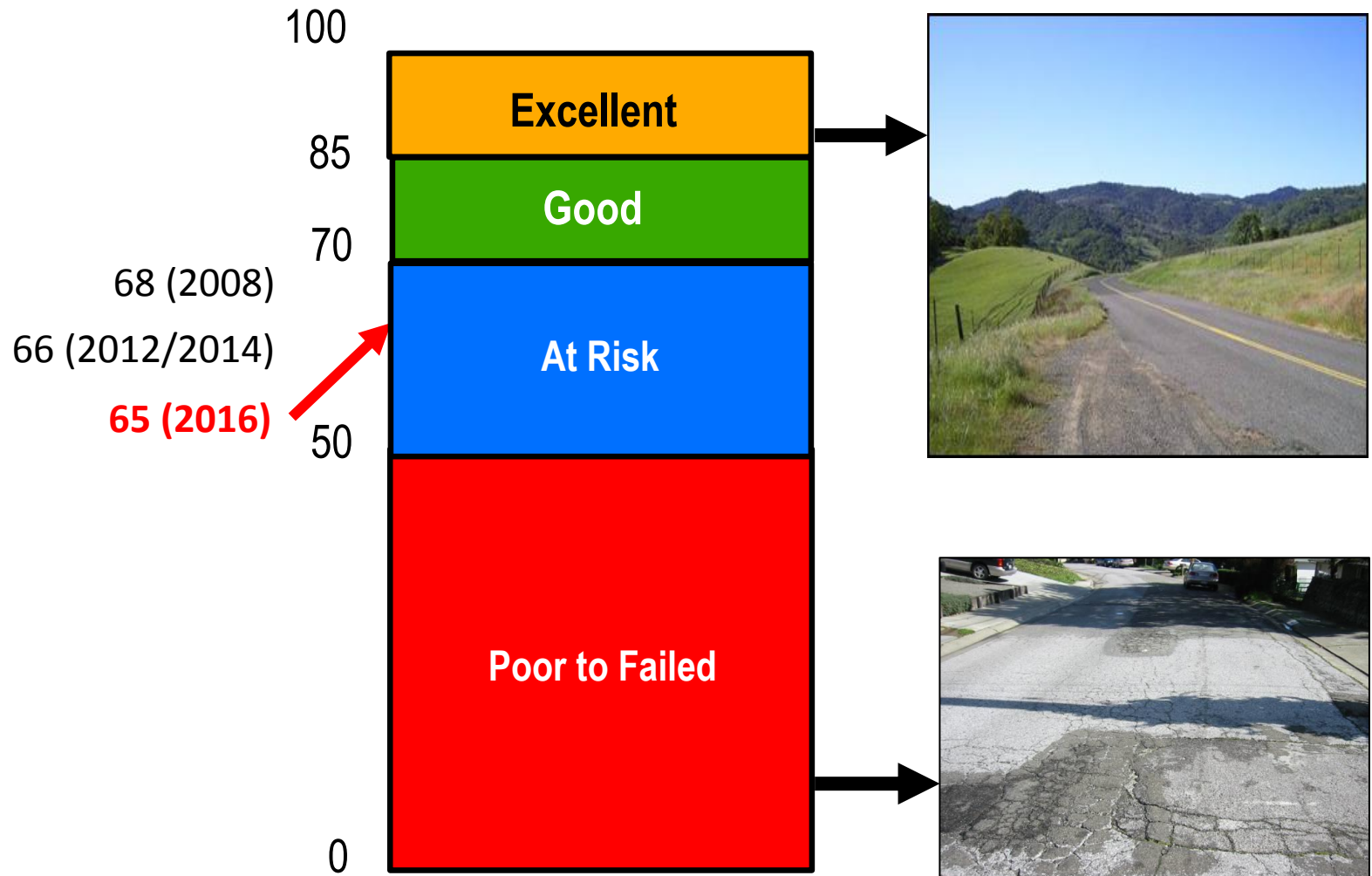

# Local Roads Are A Huge Part of California's Network

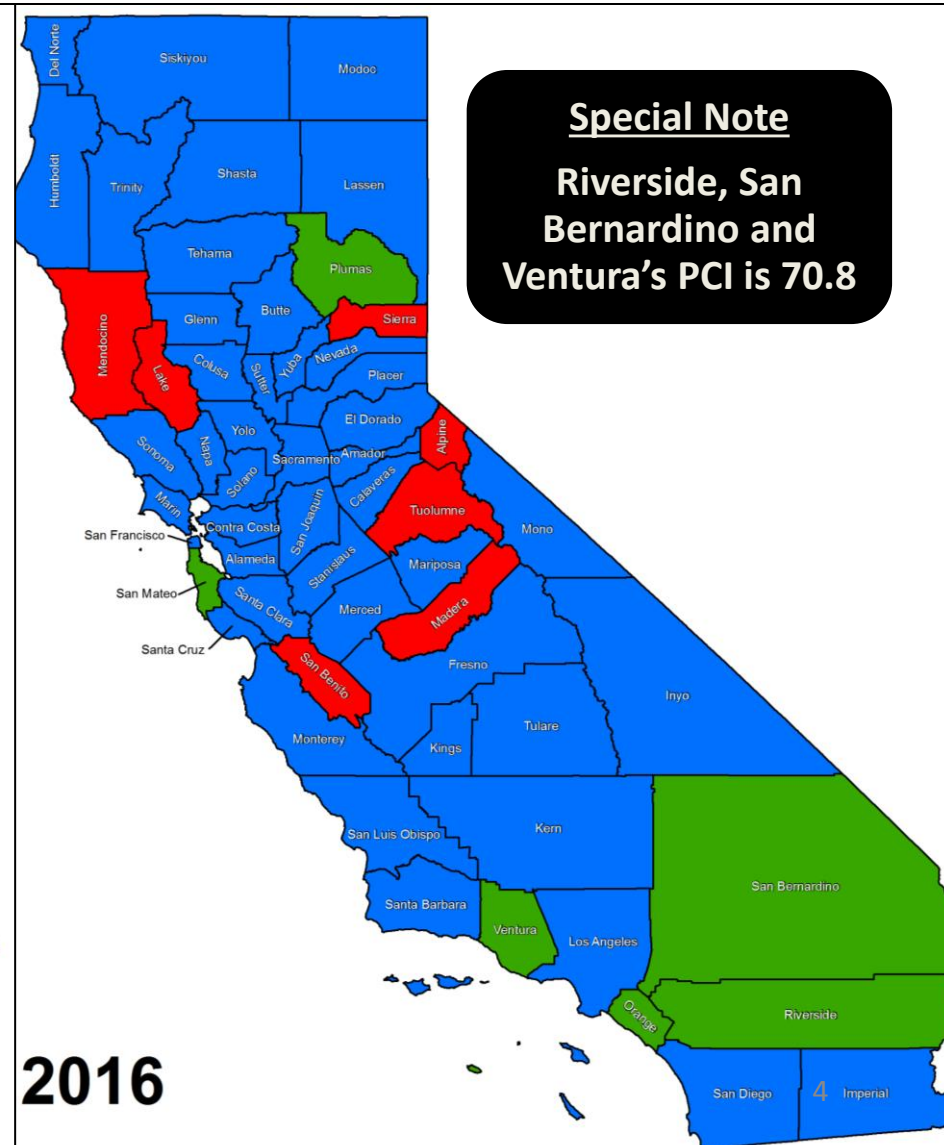
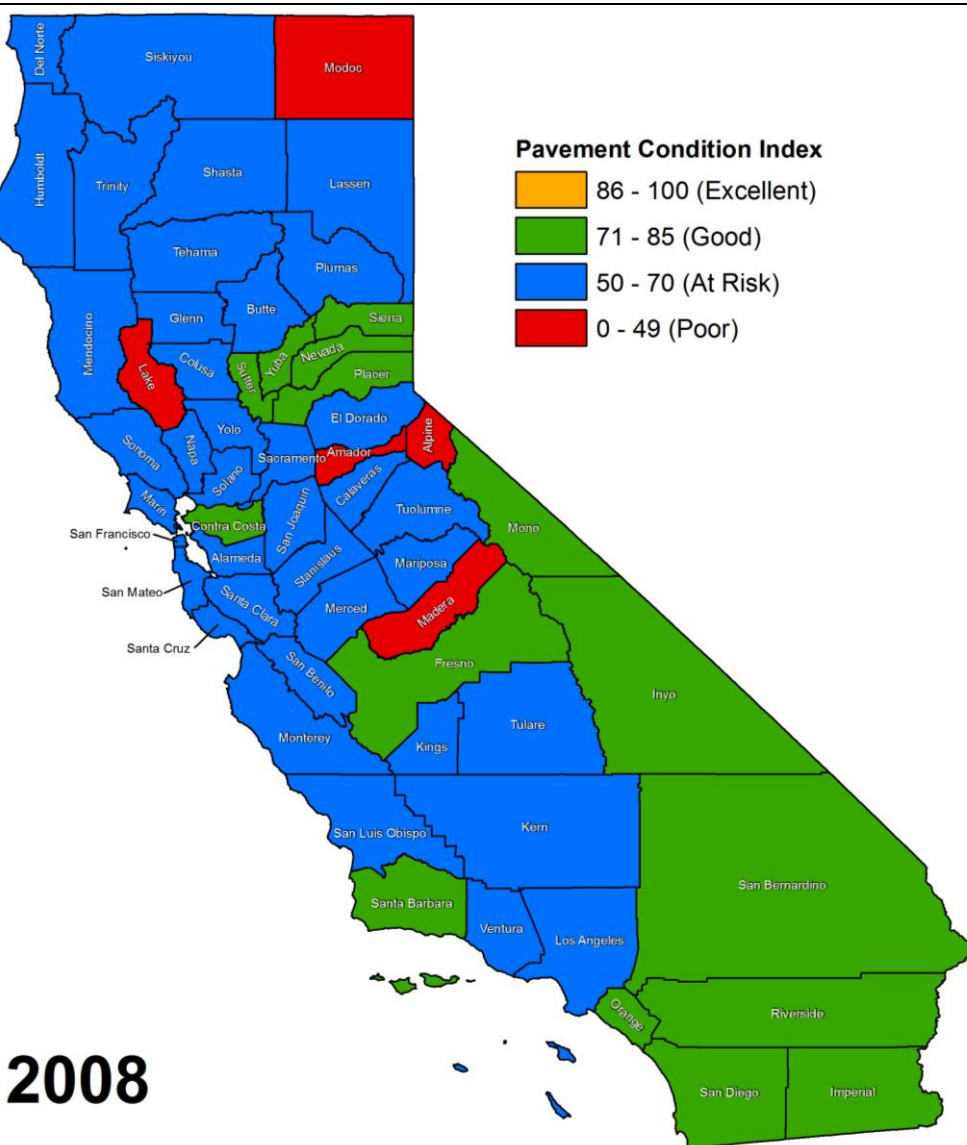
**More than 81% of California's roads are owned by cities & counties!**



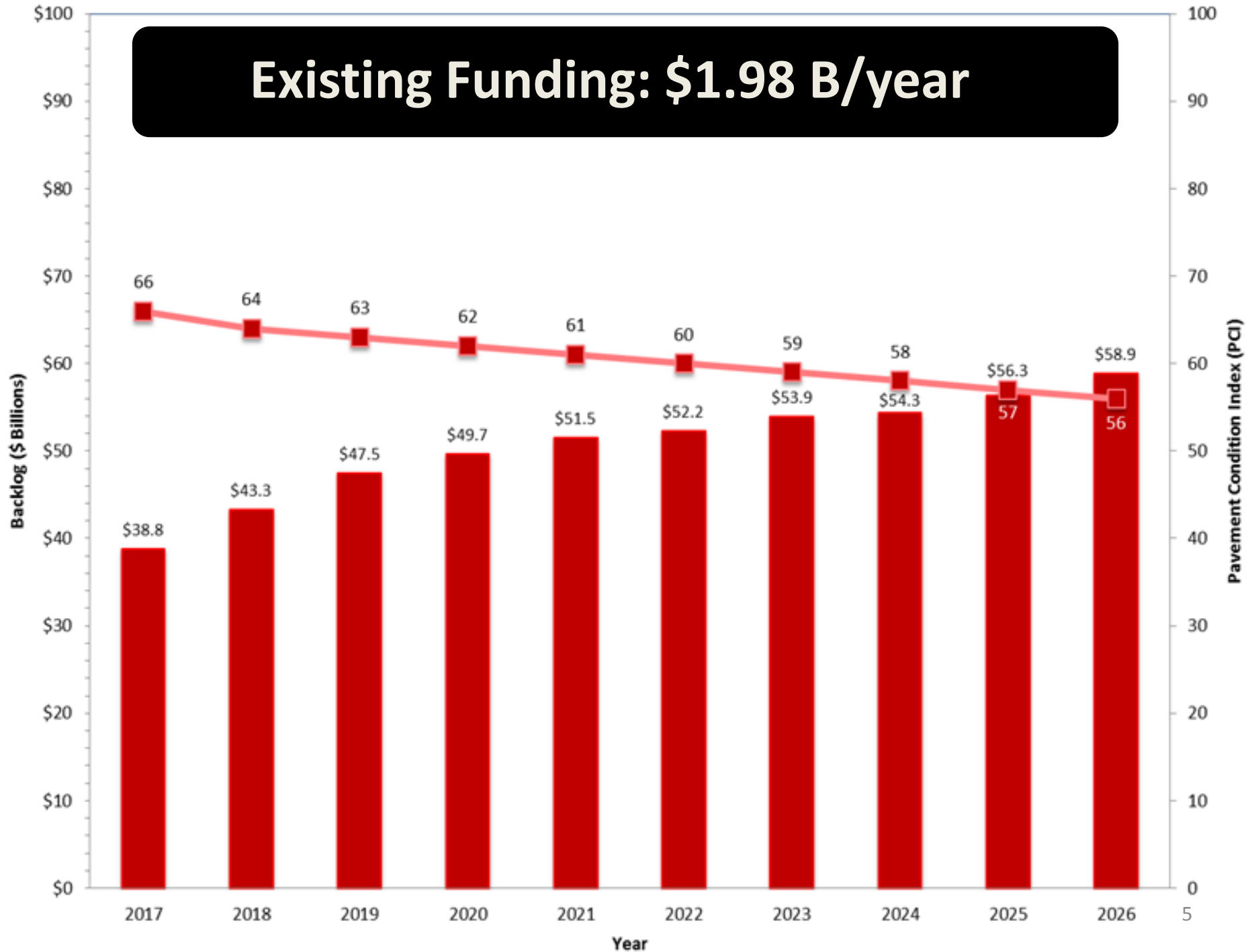
# Average Statewide PCI



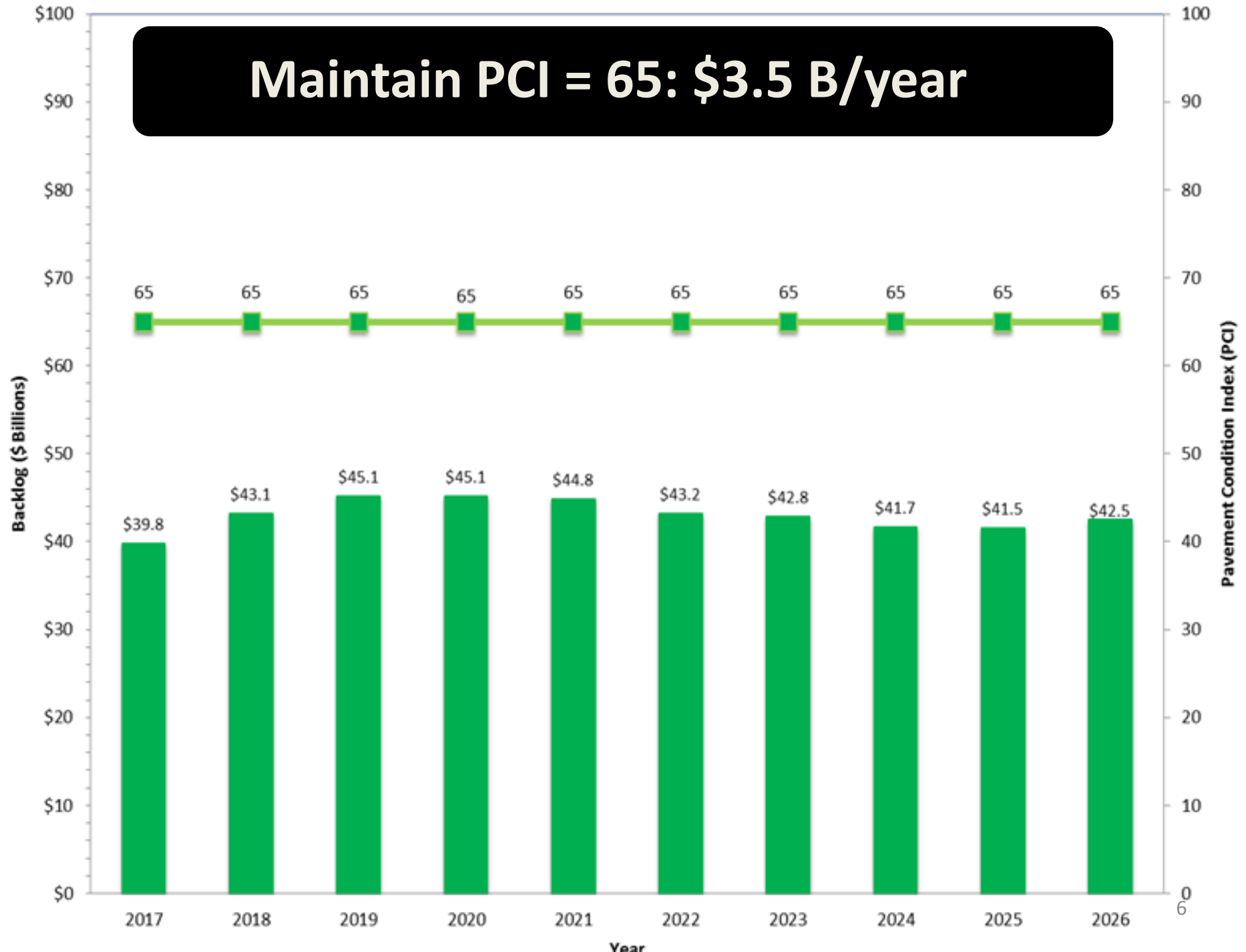
# Average PCI by County

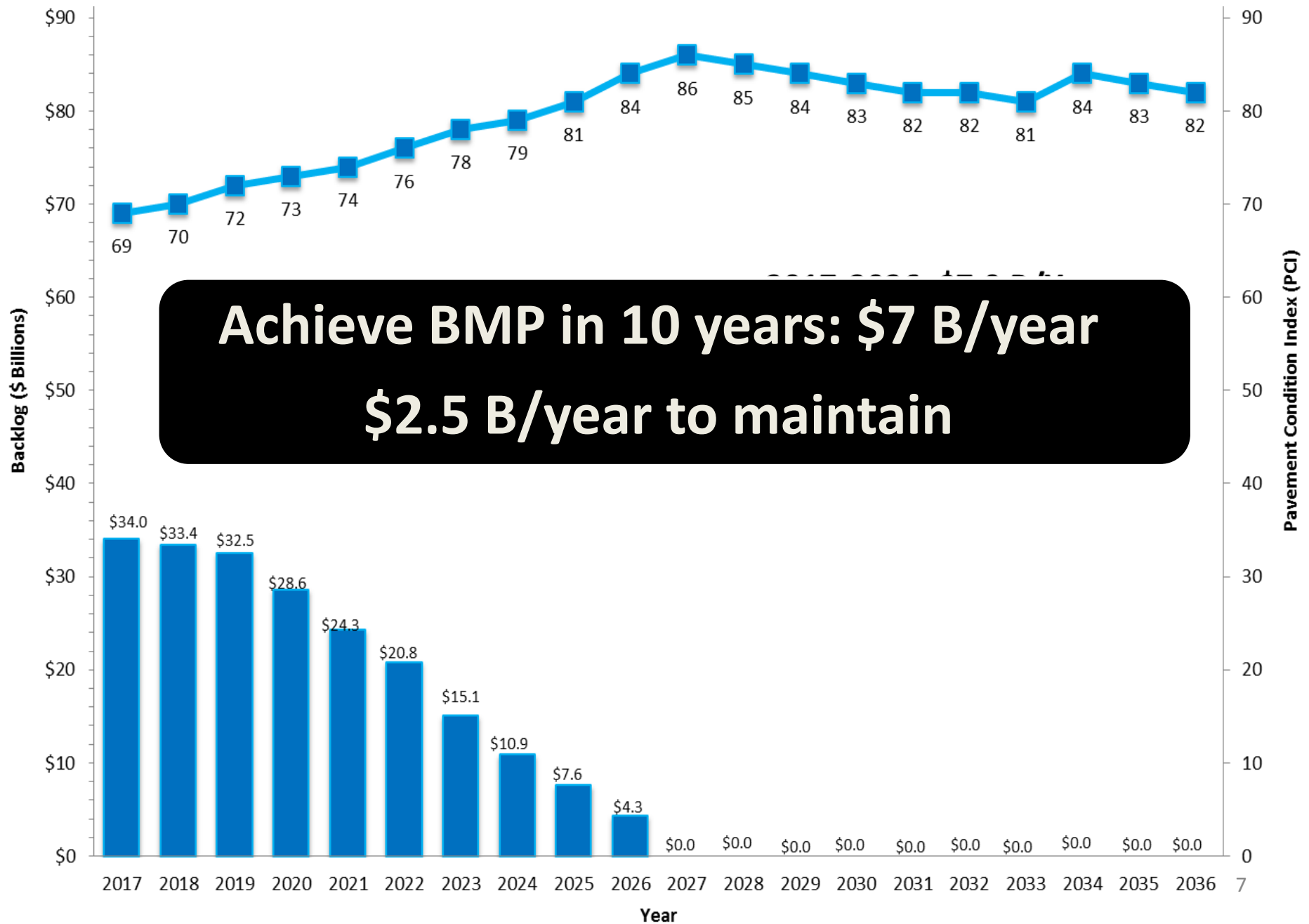


**Existing Funding: \$1.98 B/year**

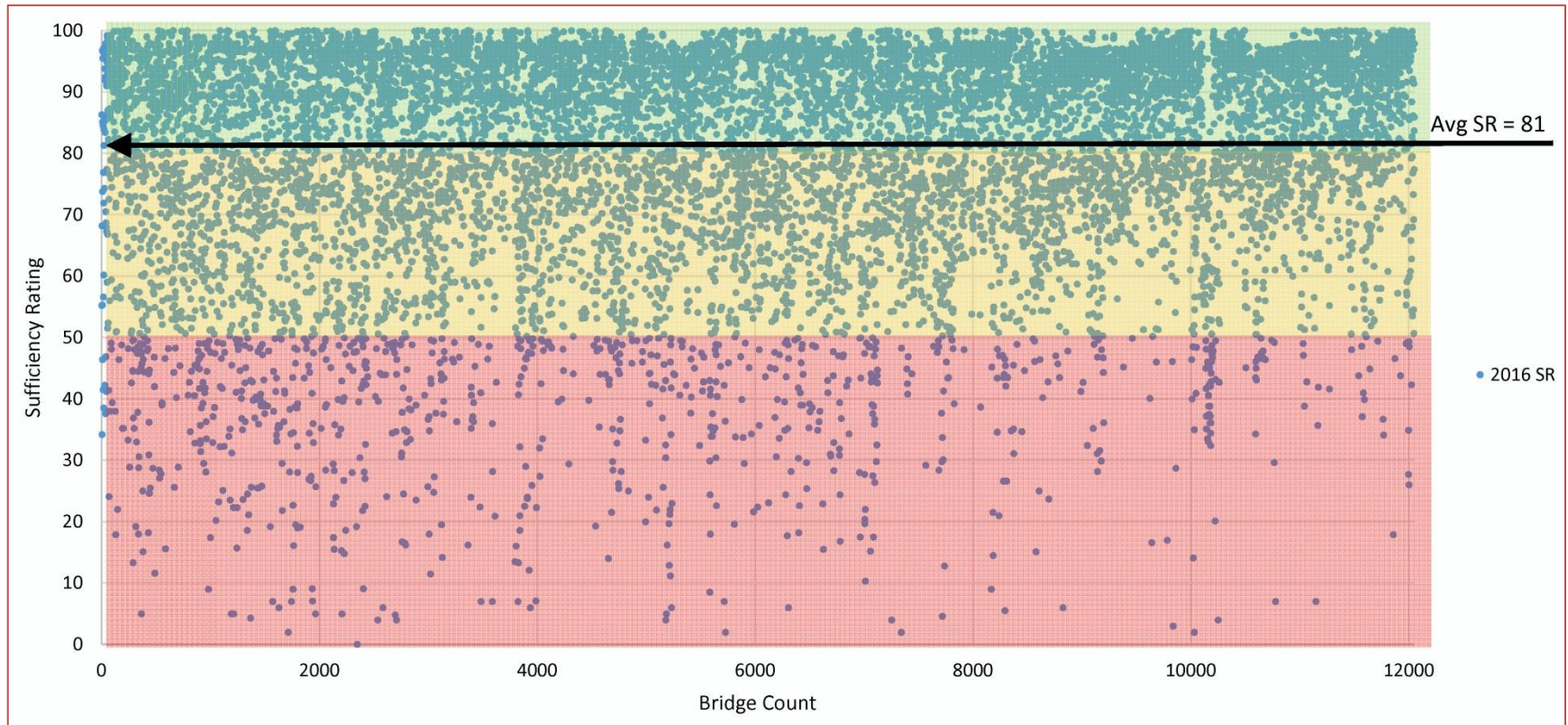

Pavement	\$ 70.0	\$ 19.8	\$ (50.2)
Essential Components	\$ 32.1	\$ 11.0	\$ (21.1)
Bridges	\$ 4.6	\$ 2.9	\$ (1.7)
Totals	\$ 106.7	\$ 33.7	\$ (73.0)



**A gas tax increase of 49 cents/gallon will erase this shortfall**



# Sufficiency Rating – All NBI Bridges



**1,448 are structurally deficient**  
**1,930 functionally obsolete**

**829 require replacement**  
**1,834 require rehabilitation**
