





PORT IMPACTS, GROWTH




- 10,000-15,000 Longshore and terminal jobs
- 192,000 jobs (about one in 11) in LA/LB
- 1 million direct/indirect jobs across the 5 So. Cal. counties (1 in 8 jobs)





ACE Legislative Priorities

- **New Revenues or Allocation Needed for the Trade Corridor Improvement Fund (TCIF) for High-Volume Freight Corridors**
 - Created as a Proposition 1B (2006) program, \$1.8 billion in bond funds leveraged for nearly \$6 billion in projects in four corridors
 - SB 1228 (Hueso) established TCIF in state law, but program remains unfunded
- **Funding/Reform Bills Supported by ACE**
 - SBX 1-1 (Beall) would provide \$300 million per year to TCIF
 - Governor's Framework would provide \$200 million per year (\$350 million to start) for TCIF
 - SCAX 1-1 (Huff) ballot measure would prohibit transportation fee/tax diversion
