Lisa manages the Lost Gear Recovery Program in Half Moon Bay, and coordinates the Fish and Fleet Festival held every September in Pillar Point Harbor to celebrate the local fishing fleet. She also manages the Half Moon Bay Groundfish Marketing Association, The Half Moon Bay Commercial Fisheries Trust and is an Advisory Board Member to the California Groundfish Collective.
