## **Senator McGuire to hold Fisheries Hearing Friday in Eureka**

*Eureka, CA* – California's fisheries have experienced unprecedented disasters and threats in recent years. Fishermen have suffered through extensive closures to crab, salmon, sardine and sea urchin seasons, while at the same time they have been challenged by risks of unintended gear entanglement with iconic whale populations.

All of this and more will be discussed during a Senate and Assembly joint committee hearing, "California Fishery Updates, Whale Protection Efforts and 2018 Legislative Recommendations" on Friday, October 27 at the Humboldt County Board of Supervisors Chambers in Eureka, California.
