Dr. Michael Graham

Dr. Michael Graham is a Professor of Marine Ecology at the Moss Landing Marine Labs (MLML), San Jose State University, where he conducts research on seaweeds and aquaculture and teaching classes on Marine Ecology, Seaweed Biology, and Aquaculture. His research focusing on kelp forests in California, the US and globally, especially the effects of climate change on the functioning of kelp systems. His aquaculture research is centered on the integration of seaweed culture systems into existing aquaculture practices (e.g. fish and shellfish). Dr. Graham is the Director of Research and Development at the newly created MLML Center for Aquaculture and is leading the charge to increase the Center's scope to include all 23 campuses in the California State University system. He is also the editor of the top algae journal in the world, the Journal of Phycology, and is a fellow of the California Academy of Sciences.
