7.	SB 1003	Jones	Skateboard parks: other wheeled recreational devices: safety and liability. (Urgency)

11.	SB 1146	Umberg	Civil procedure: electronic filing and remote depositions. The proposed amendments would clarify and contain the scope of the bill's remote deposition provisions. Amendment 1 would remove a provision stating that any person may take or attend a deposition remotely, because the language could be interpreted to allow deponents to elect to appear remotely; it further adds that, at the election of the deposing party or the deponent, the deposition officer may appear remotely. Amendment 2 would clarify that the right of other participants to attend a deposition in personeven where the deposition officer is appearing remotelyremains subject to the right to seek a protective order under Code of Civil Procedure section 2025.420. Amendment 3 would add a subdivision clarifying that the provisions allowing the deposition officer to attend remotely do not alter any of the other time, place, and manner requirements regarding depositions.
