- Spent only for transportation purposes (e.g., excludes VLF)

Method:

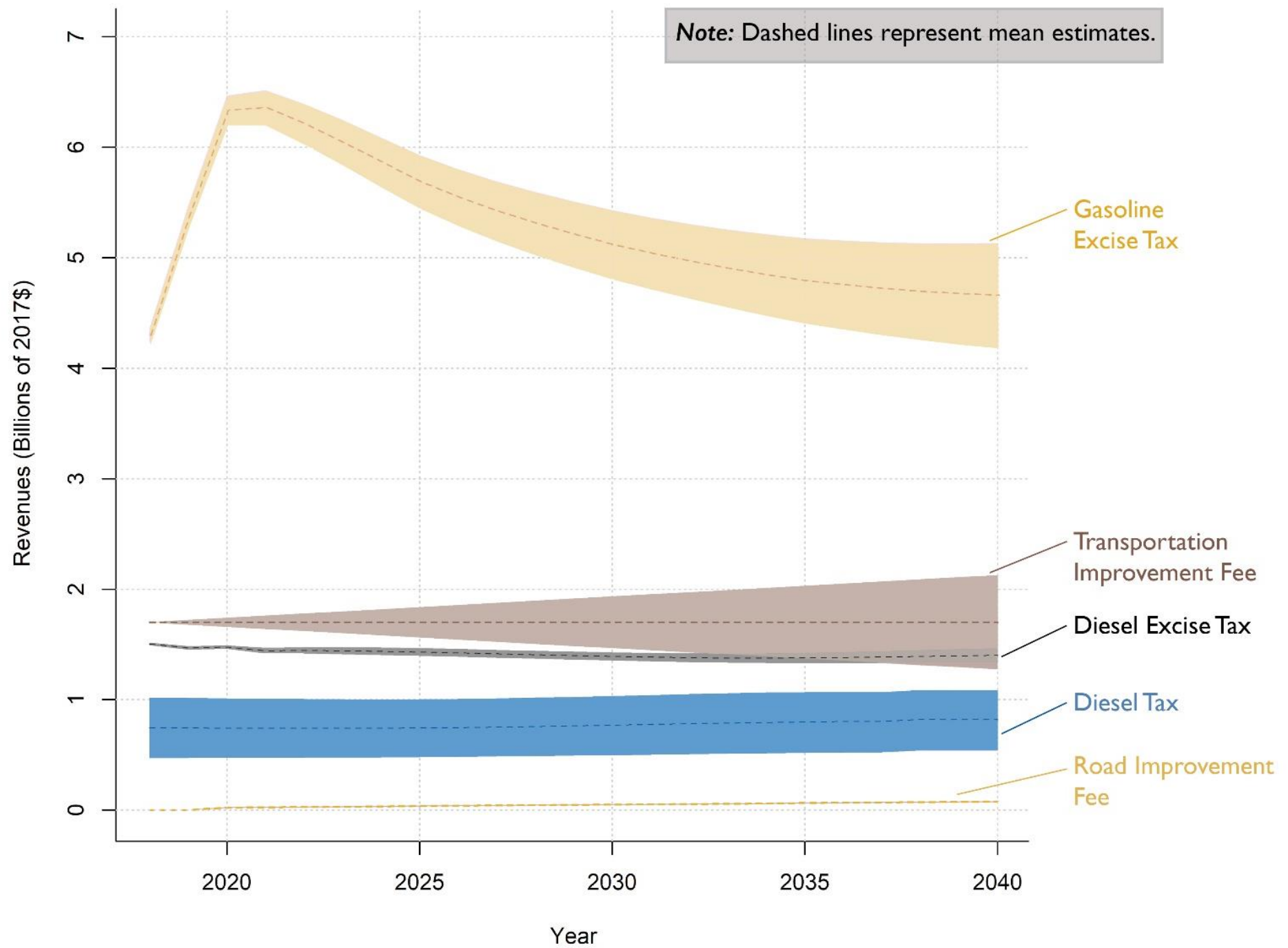
- Spreadsheet models

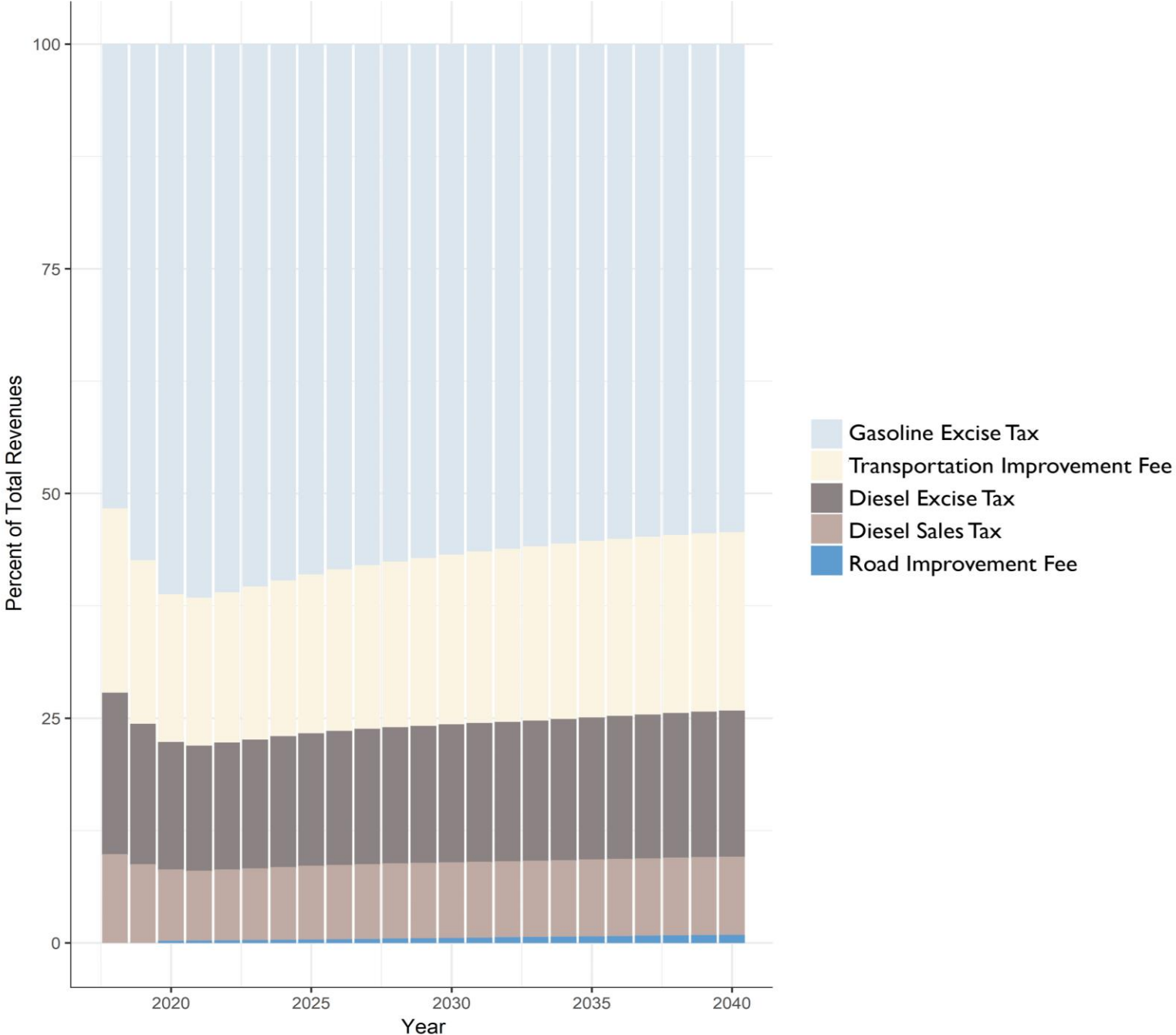

# State Transportation Revenue Projections, by Revenue Type, 2018 - 2040

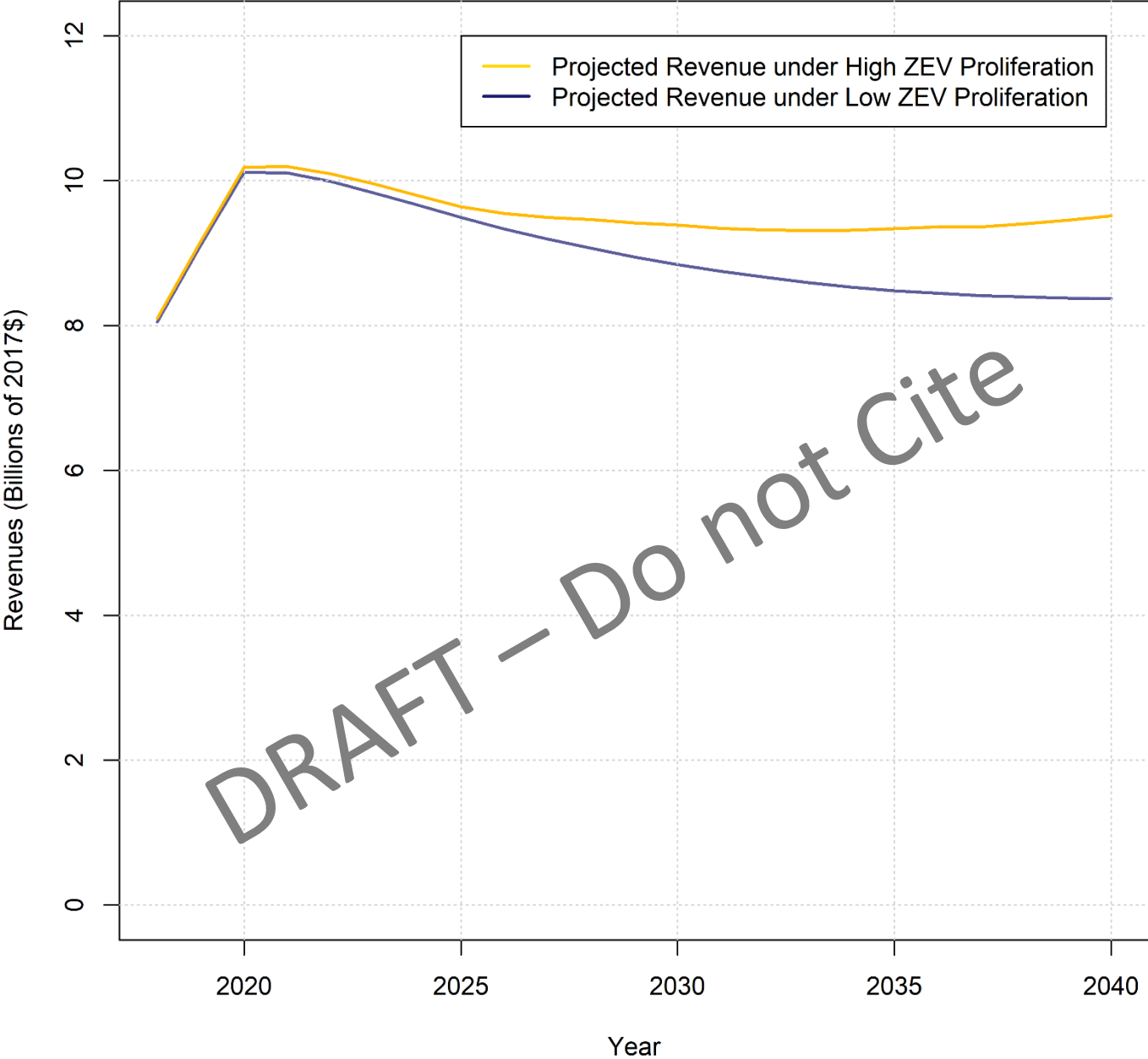


# Contribution by Revenue Source, 2018 - 2040

### Method:

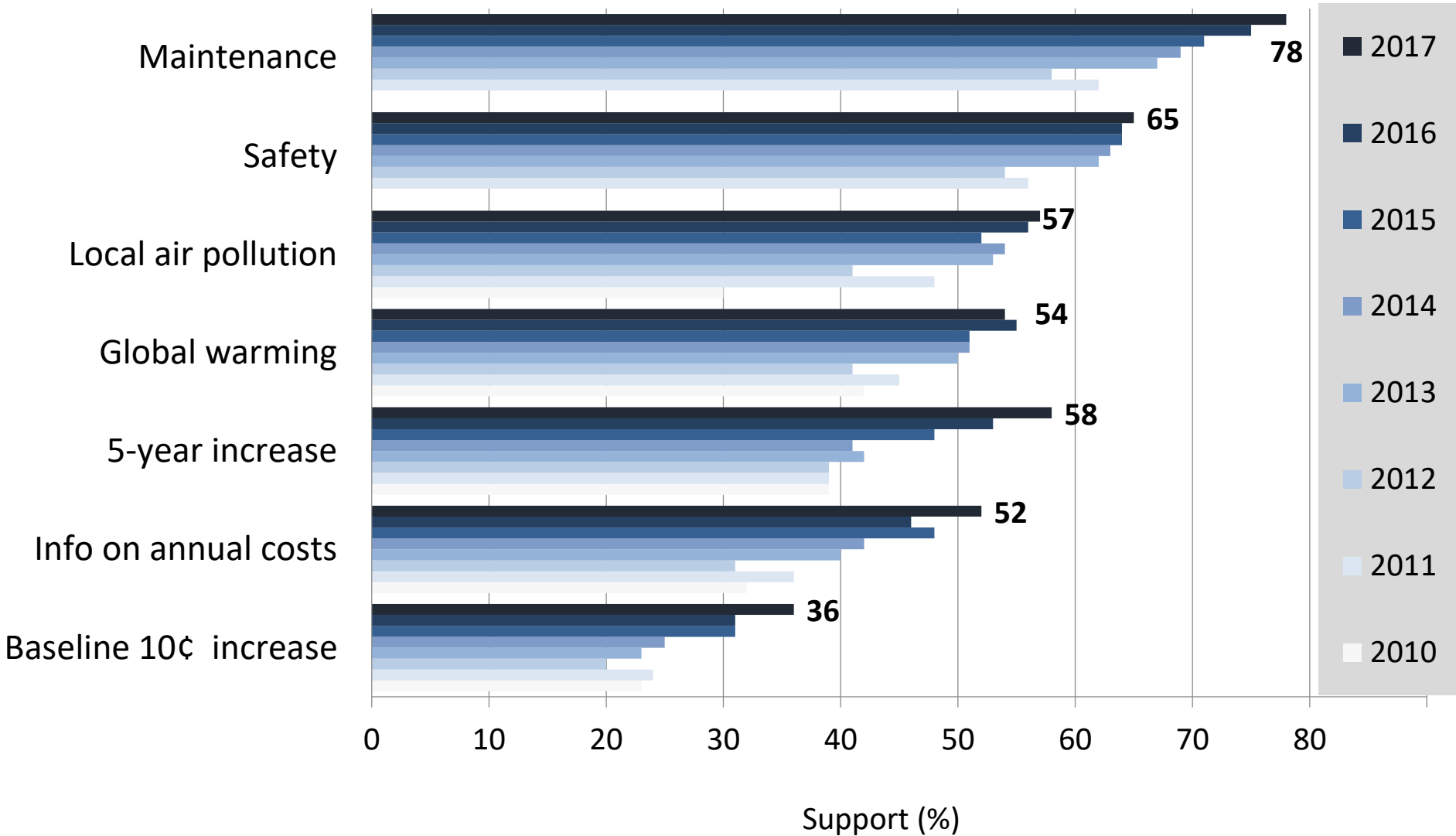
- 9 annual surveys, 2010 - 2018
