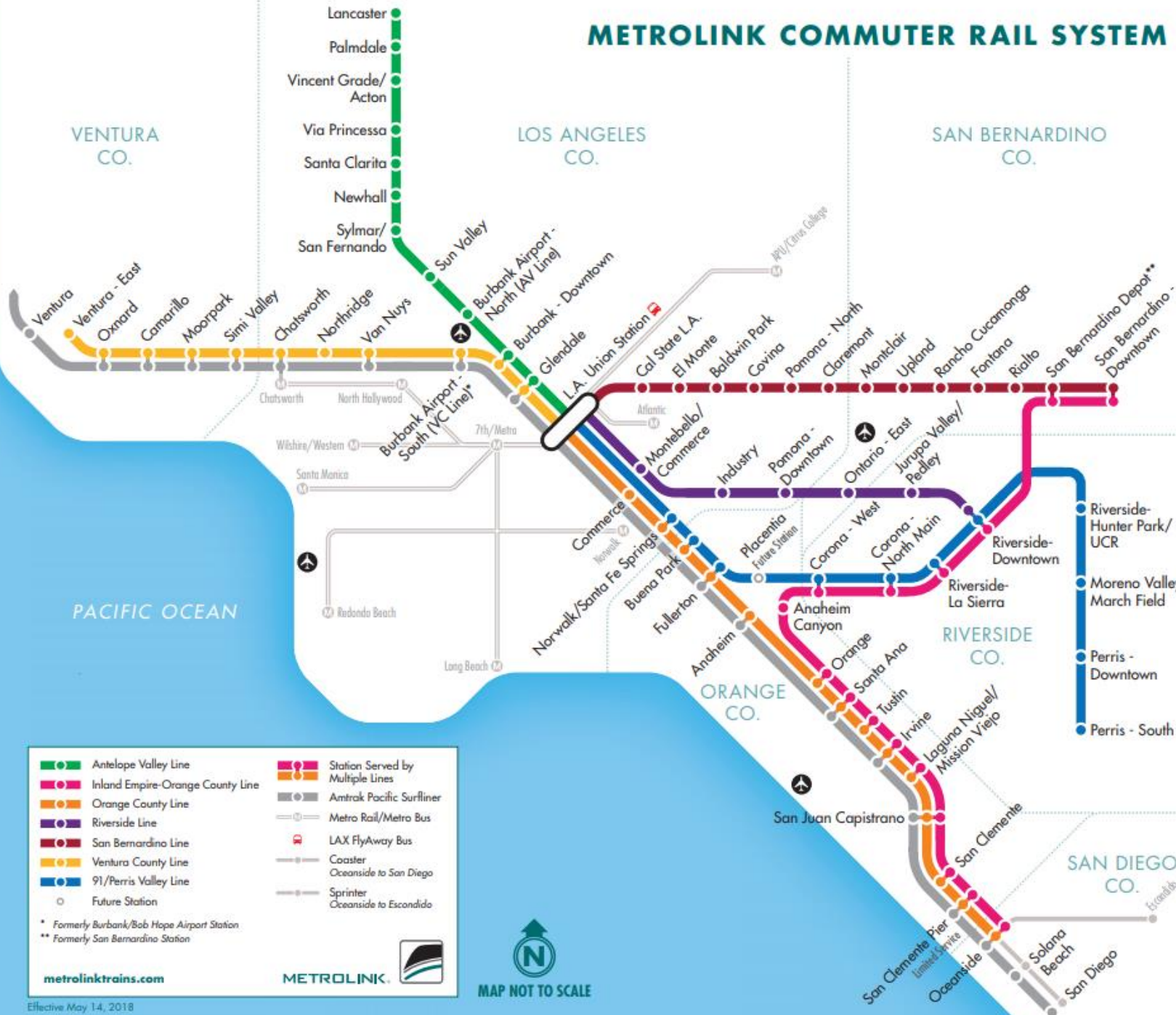

# METROLINK COMMUTER RAIL SYSTEM



Metrolink operates on seven routes across a six-county, 538 route-miles network.

Commuter rail provides the same capacity as two lanes of parallel freeway traffic.

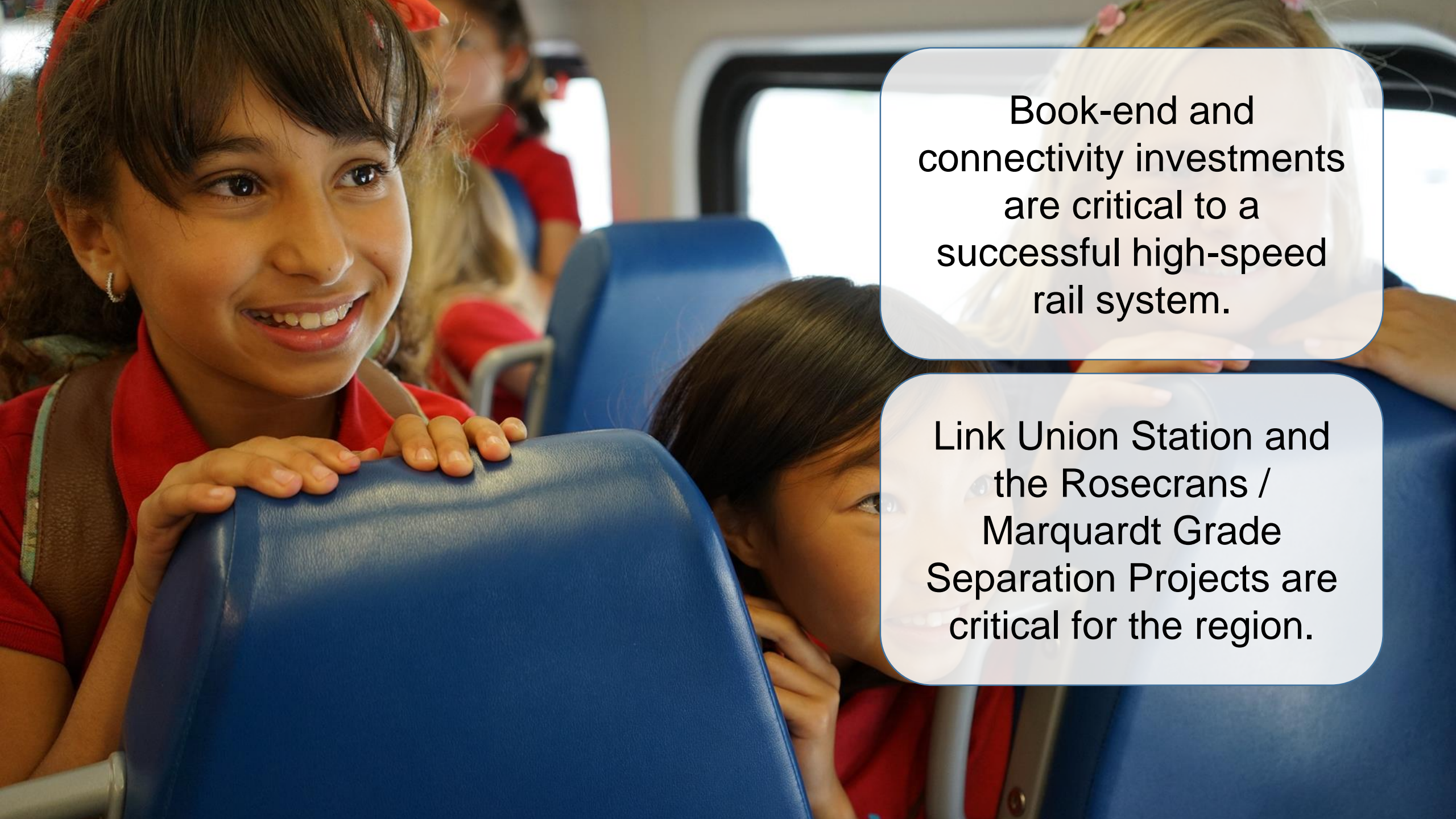


Commuter rail is part of a regional solution to ease congestion on all major freeways and connect residents to opportunities.
