Citizens Redistricting Commission—Operational Costs

Pursuant to Provision 5 of Item 0911-001-0001, 2019 Budget Act, the following request is respectfully submitted.

The Department of Finance has received a request from the Citizens Redistricting Commission to use \$1,313,000 General Fund included in the 2019 Budget for operational costs.

Provision 5 of Item 0911-001-0001, 2019 Budget Act, specifies that \$1,313,000 is available, after August 15, 2020, for operational costs related to Chapter 271, Statutes of 2012 (SB 1096). The United States Census Bureau originally planned to deliver redistricting data to all states by March 31, 2021, but announced that it will instead deliver redistricting data to all states by September 30, 2021. This delay, coupled with the impacts of the COVID-19 Pandemic, has extended the Commission's overall redistricting activities and costs. The Commission is currently rapidly expanding staff resources and expenditures to support the preparation and certification of the final maps. Therefore, this funding is now needed to support the Commission's increased operational costs. In addition, the May Revision includes \$8,472,000 General Fund for fiscal year 2021-22 to support extended redistricting activities. We concur with the necessity of this request and will be approving the request not sooner than 30 days from the submission to the Joint Legislative Budget Committee.

Subject: Request for the Release of Operational Funds for the California Citizens Redistricting Commission.

Dear Ms. Bosler,

In accordance with Provision 5 of Item 0911-001-0001, 2019 Budget Act, the California Citizens Redistricting Commission (Commission) requests the release of \$1,313,000 already appropriated by the Legislature for operational costs that will be incurred towards the end of fiscal year 2020-21. Though Provision 5 specifies this funding was available after August 15, 2020, delays in Commission activities as a result of COVID-19 and the late release of U.S. Census data have not warranted its use until now. The Commission is in the midst of rapidly expanding its staffing and expenditure rate to support the preparation and certification of final maps in fiscal year 2021-22. This component of the Commission's fiscal year 2019-20 appropriation has been included in the overall budget for its three-year redistricting process, which was publicly approved by the Commission on April 1, 2021. The budget also reflects a need for additional funding in fiscal year 2021-22 that has been addressed in a separate request.
