Dear Ms. Bosler:

In a letter dated April 8, 2022, you notified the Joint Legislative Budget Committee, pursuant to Item 8120-002-0001, Provision 2 in the 2021-22 Budget Act, of a request from the Commission on Peace Officer Standards and Training (POST) to transfer \$2,184,000 General Fund from Program 6505-Training to Program 6500-Standards to implement provisions of SB 2 (Bradford). The transfer will allow POST to purchase and configure a case management system and hire five key positions. The case management system, which must be operational by January 1, 2023, will allow POST to collect, track, investigate and store allegations of peace officer misconduct.

I have reviewed the notification and concur with the request to transfer the funds. In addition, I waive the remainder of the 30-day review period, in order to allow POST to promptly procure the case management system and meet the deadline established by SB 2.
