Dear Ms. Bosler:

In a letter dated March 4, 2021, you notified the Joint Legislative Budget Committee that an addendum was reached between the State and the Service Employees International Union, Local 1000 (State Bargaining Units 1, 3, 4, 11, 14, 15, 17, 20, and 21) to allow the State Controller's Office (SCO) to process an increase in the State Disability Insurance that was not captured for the January 1, 2021 payments to represented employees. The accounts receivables via payroll deductions will be established for the March 2021 pay period to collect the repayments. The letter requested a waiver from the 30-day legislative review period.
