Dear Ms. Bosler:

In a letter dated June 1, 2021, you notified the Joint Legislative Budget Committee (JLBC), pursuant to the provisions of Section 28.00 of the 2020-21 Budget Act, of a request from the Department of Aging to increase its federal fund expenditure authority in Item 4170-101-0890 by \$1,563,000. The funding will be distributed to 17 designated and emerging Aging & Disability Resource Connection (ADRC) programs to help improve COVID-19 vaccination access for older adults and disabled individuals.
