*Approve as budgeted with budget bill language requiring CDCR to engage stakeholders throughout the implementation of the transfer and report to the appropriate legislative budget committees on progress during 2018 spring budget hearings. (Assembly 5-0) (Senate 5-0)*
- Page 18**     **Issue 16**     **State Juvenile Justice Facilities**  
*Conference Compromise: Redirect \$500,000 from the existing Division of Juvenile Justice (DJJ) budget for innovative programming grants. Plus Senate augmentation of \$750,000 General Fund to the Arts Council for JumpStArts and an expansion of the grant program to the DJJ state facilities. (Assembly 3-2) (Senate 5-0)*
- Page 19**     **Issue 17**     **Expansion of Parole Opportunities and Support for Parolees**  
*Conference Compromise: Trailer bill language adjusting the terms of commitment for people found not guilty by reason of insanity consistent with the changes included in Propositions 36 and 47. Provides \$2 million and necessary trailer bill language for the Supervised Population Workforce Training Grant fund programs to develop competitive workforce training programs for individuals on parole, probation, mandatory supervision, and post release community supervision. In addition, \$250,000 one-time*

*General Fund for expansion of the Underground Scholars program to the community colleges. (Assembly 3-2) (Senate 3-2)*

- Page 20**    **Issue 18**    **Maintaining and Expanding Rehabilitation Programming**  
*Conference Compromise: Require that \$5.5 million in existing rehabilitation funds be redirected for one year to continue innovative programming for long term offenders. In addition, \$5 million one-time General Fund to ensure that career technical education (CTE) participants and CDCR have the necessary resources and equipment to effectively implement CTE programs. (Assembly 3-2) (Senate 3-2)*
